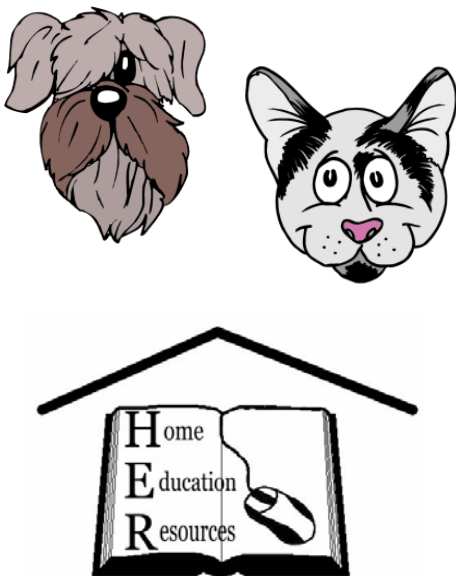

TIPS FOR PRINTING & USE:

If possible, print on card stock and laminate or cover with clear contact paper for durability.

Ideas for use:

1. Cut out around cards and give children all or selected cards. Have children match sets of the same animal and put each animal set in order from smallest to biggest.
2. For each set, have children repeat after you: "Small, medium, large" or "Smallest, middle, biggest", etc.
3. Only the biggest and smallest of each set can be given, for easier practice between big and small with no "medium".
4. Cards can also be used for other practice games: Find a cat the same size, a dog that is bigger than mine, a small dog with spots, etc.
