TIPS FOR PRINTING & USE:

If possible, print on card stock and laminate or cover with clear contact paper for durability. Make 2 copies of pages 2 & 3, if desired.

Ideas for use:

1. Cut out around outside edges of cards, so that there are 2 pictures on each card, 2 cards per row, 10 cards per page.
2. For easiest play, give children one domino at a time and have them place it on the table so that one or both sides touches another domino, with the same pictures touching (like classic dominoes). This way, the game leader can cut down on frustration by giving only cards that can be played immediately.
3. For more challenging play, split up the dominoes between two or more players, and have them place one domino each turn.
4. During play, discuss the colors and shapes on the cards. Which three cards show purple? Which objects are most like circles?
